

REPORT ON JUDICIAL PANEL OF ENQUIRY SITTING IN MAKURDI

CASE 1.

JACINTHA MELLADU VS A.I.G ZONE 4 (BSJPI/040/21)

FACTS: The petitioner in 2016, was arrested, harassed, intimidated, detained and subjected to further inhuman treatment by men of the Nigerian Police Force in Makurdi the Benue state capital. She filed an action in court with motion No: MHC/127/2016 for enforcement of her fundamental rights. The court in judgment, awarded the sum of N500,000.00 to the petitioner, the said sum the police has refused to honour. The petitioner has approached the Judicial panel of enquiry to seek justice and compel the police to honour the judgement of the court.

LAWYERS ALERT and partners are representing the petitioner at the panel for the attainment of justice for the petitioner. Matter is adjourned to the 3rd of March 2021 for continuation of hearing.

CASE 2

WANDOO TERDOO TYOKUA VS SARS (BSJPI/40/20)

FACTS: The petitioner has approached the panel for justice over the extra judicial killing of her husband by men of SARS in 2019.

LAWYERS ALERT and partners are representing the petitioner at the panel for the attainment of justice for the petitioner. Matter is adjourned to the 1st of March 2021 for continuation of hearing.

CASE 3

MONICA ERDOO MAASHIN VS COP BENUE (BSJPI/062/21)

FACTS: The petitioner has approached the court to demand justice for the extrajudicial killing of her younger brother by men of SARS in 2015. They deposited his corpse at the Federal Medical Centre Makurdi mortuary with tally number 224 with an instruction for the body not to be released. The petitioner has approached the panel to seek redress and demand for the release of the corpse of her brother so they can observe proper funeral rite for the deceased.

LAWYERS ALERT and partners are representing the petitioner at the panel for the attainment of justice for the petitioner. Matter is adjourned to the 2nd of March 2021 for continuation of hearing.
